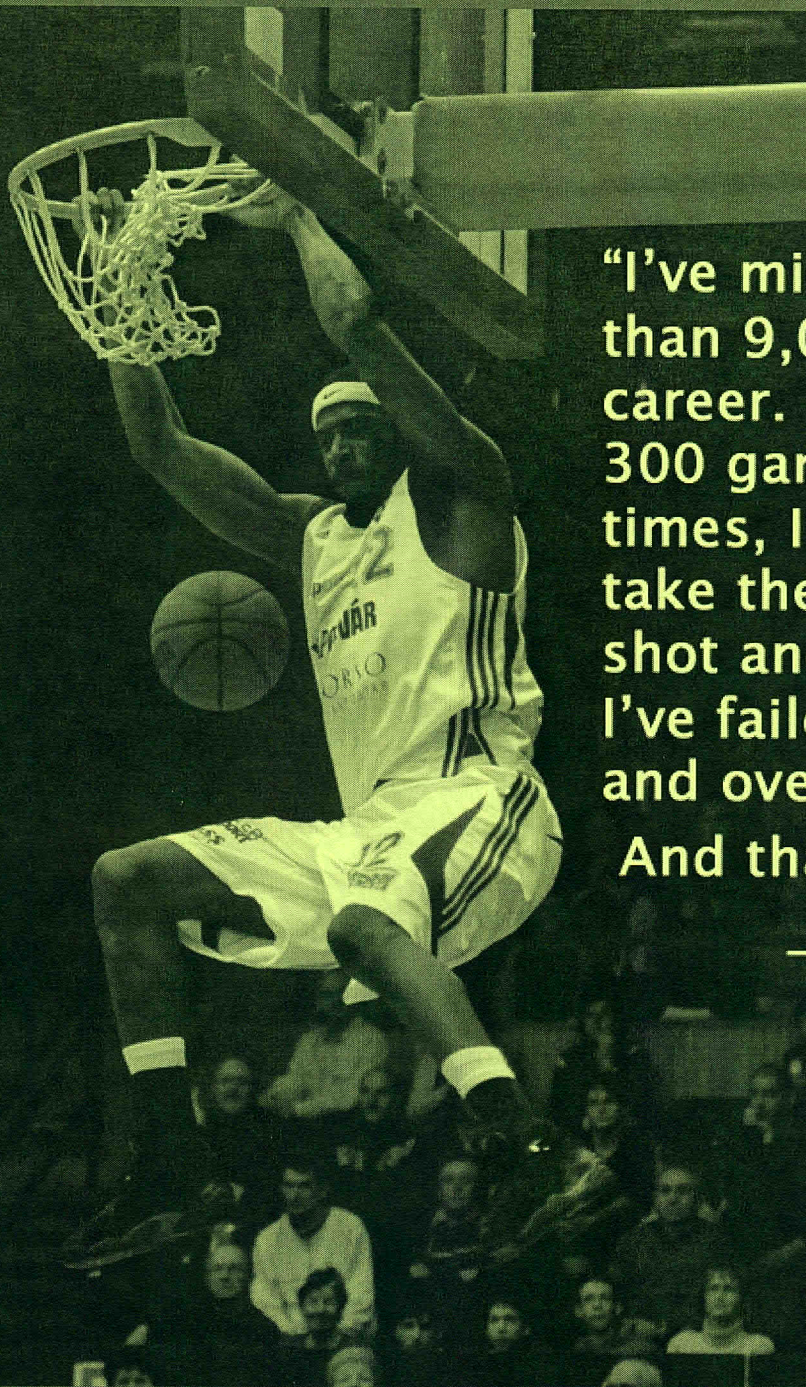


# BASKETBALL
